



Document Checklist – PSARA License

In order to obtain a license under the Private Security Agencies Regulation Act, 2005, the following documents must be submitted,

- 1. Application in form
- 2. Affidavit as per the PSARA Act, outlining -
 - That the person applying is not disqualified under the provisions of Section 6 of the Act.
 - That training will be made available for private security guards, as required under Section 9(2) of the Act.
 - That the conditions under Section 11 of the Act are met.
 - That there are no cases registered with the police against the applicant.
- 3. Ownership proof for the principal place of business.
- 4. Logo of the security agency.
- 5. Identity cards for all employees.
- 6. Detailed armed licenses.
- 7. Character verification certificate of the employees.
- 8. Uniform pattern of the Agency.
- 9. Certificate of Incorporation, MOA/AOA or Partnership Deed.
- 10. The precondition for PSARA License Registration

Before applying for the PSARA license, the following documentation needs to be done:

- 1. Allotment of PAN.
- 2. GST Registration.
- 3. PF Registration.
- 4. ESI Registration.
- 5. Shop & Establishment Registration.
- 6. Registration under Contractual Labour (Regulation and Abolition) Act.

To acquire PSARA permit, you may need to pay the accompanying expense -

- For Private Security Agencies in One District Rs. 5000
- For a Private Security organization in 5 district Rs. 10000
- For a Private Security office in the entire state Rs. 25000
